Cohesive devices are transitional words or phrases that tie together logical ideas in a written work. Cohesive devices serve as a road map for the reader to understand ideas or the purpose of the writing.

Cohesive devices, sometimes called linking words, linkers, connectors, discourse markers or transitional words. Cohesive Devices are words or phrases that show the relationship between paragraphs or sections of a text or speech. Cohesive devices affect comprehension because they help readers integrate information between sentences in a text. The pronoun, synonym, or transition word is tied to a previous word, phrase or clause (the antecedent). Many students, even skilled readers, never consciously think about authors' use of cohesive devices.
